

KYTHNOS-SYROS-MYKONOS (2 DAYS)

DISTANCE: 185 miles

CRUISING TIME: 7 Hours

CROUISING SPEED: 30 Knots

PROGRAM

9:30-10.00 Boarding

Boarding from our base, the Navex Yacht Parking at Harakas Beach in Legrena Attica and traveling to Loutra (Kythnos).

11:00 Loutra (Kythnos)

In less than an hour (29 miles) we stay at the port of Kythnos Baths. The baths are famous for their healing springs, known since antiquity as they have been found in the area. It is worth a stop for a coffee and a walk in the picturesque little harbor with the shops and why not a dip in the beach that ends in the warm waters of the spas.

12:00 Departure

Departure for the port of Syros.

13:30 Syros

In less than 1.30 hours (31 miles) we reach Ermoupolis, the capital of the Cyclades, at the port of Syros. It is distinguished for its beauty with the picturesque alleys and the architectural style that is not found anywhere else in the Cyclades. You can dine and stroll loosely, from classic venues such as Miaouli Square and Ziller's famous town hall, to the wide staircase and palm trees, as well as the Apollo Theater (worth a look inside to admire the classy décor). which "suffocates" in its small interior). Impressive are the churches of Agios Nikolaos and the Resurrection and of course the Syrian mansions.

15:30 Departure

Departure for the Rinia (Mykonos).

16:15 Rinia (Mykonos)

In less than an hour (15 miles) we arrive at the Rhine for diving and exploring the turquoise waters.

Stop for 1.30 hours



17:45 Departure

To the final destination.

18:15 Mykonos

In less than half an hour (12 miles) we reach the port of Mykonos.

Next Day we start

9:30-10.00 Boarding

We start exploring the most famous beaches along Mykonos with various stops for diving and exploring for about 3 hours (10 miles).

13:00 Departure

We start for a visit to the archaeological site of Delos very close to Mykonos.

13:30 Dilos

In less than half an hour (7 miles) we reach Delos, located southwest of Mykonos at 6 nautical miles. This small island in antiquity was a religious and cultural center and is known as the sacred island of Apollo. Stop for a visit, bath and snack on board.

15:00 Departure

Departure for a quick stop at Kolona, of Kythnos

17:00 Kolona bay (Kythnos)

In less than 2 hours (55 miles)we reach the beach of Kolona, in the northwest of the island, which is incredible. A narrow strip of sand, which connects Kythnos with the islet of St. Luke, divides the sea in the middle, offering... two sandy beaches on the same beach! Diving in both. Although the island has many excellent beaches of unique beauty, this is the most photographed and famous because of the peculiarity of the enchanting landscape. From a particular point on the west side, they spill warm thermal waters on one of its beaches.

Stop about 1,30 hours.



18:30 Departure

To the final destination.

19:30 Harakas Beach

In less than an hour (25 miles) we reach Haraka beach where the landing takes place. The beach is huge, one of the largest in Attica. You can end your day by relaxing on the sun loungers and enjoying the awesome sunset with a cocktail at the Beach Bar.
